We have been using IXL in our 1996 Buick Roadmaster Wagon, 1992 Buick Roadmaster Wagon, 1991 Buick Roadmaster Wagon and 1966 Cadillac convertible for probably 5 years or close to it. These cars with the exception of the 66 have milage ranging from 130,000 (92), 190,000 (96) and 265,000 (91). The 91 was using a quart of oil to 800 miles and is now down to maybe a quart to 1800 mi. We go much longer between changes and get much better gas milage. The 91 got a new transmission at 140,000. None of the others have had to have a different one even with the milage and age. One thing Roadmasters are not noted for is long lating transmissions. Thank you IXL I don't want to lose my wagons they don't make them anymore and frankly they don't make anything I want to drive or ride in. I hope my Roadmasters last forever.
